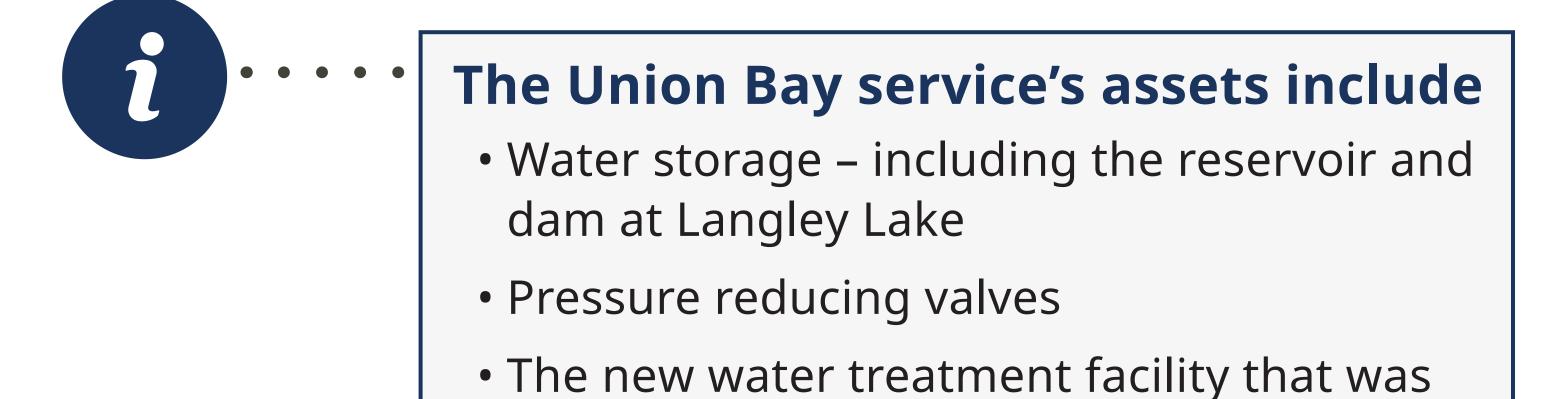
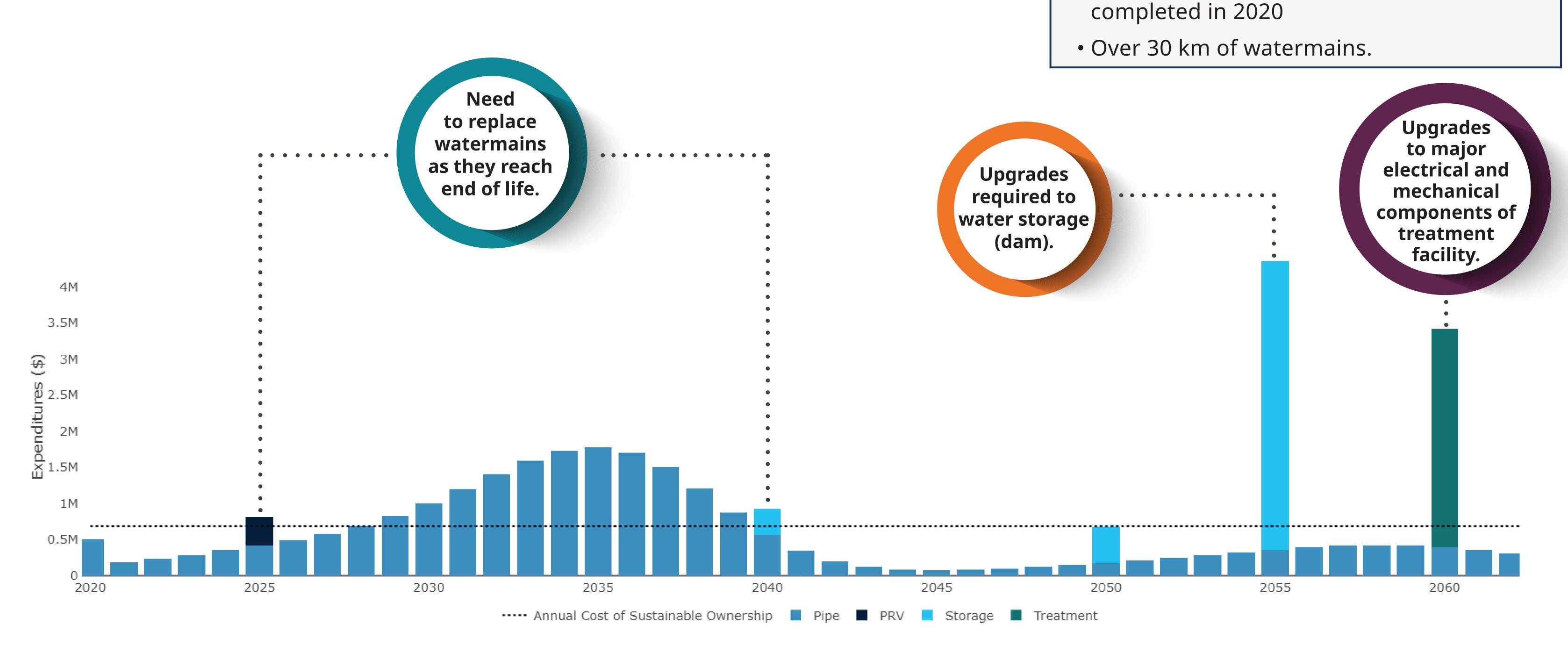
## Union Bay: Assets & Replacements

The Union Bay Water Local Service Area became a service of the Comox Valley Regional District in 2021, when the Union Bay Improvement District converted.







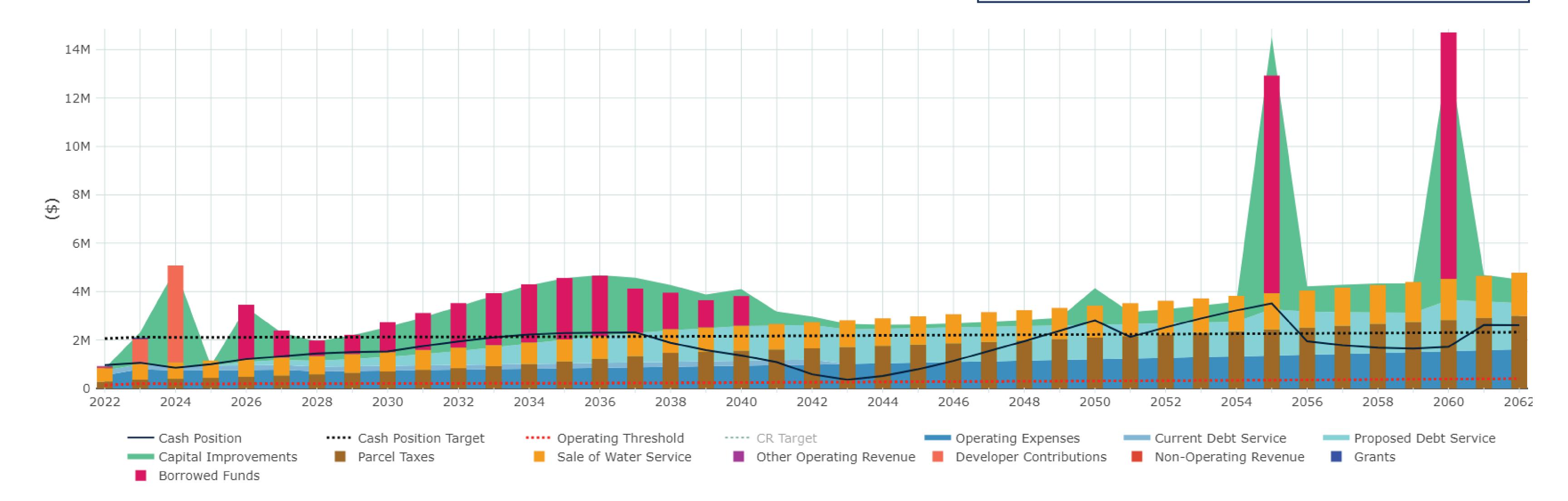
## Union Bay: Planning Costs Ahead

The long-term financial model maps out the necessary operations and maintenance costs and capital costs to ensure sustainable delivery of the water service.



## The long-term financial model assumes:

- A 2.5 % inflation factor on all operations and maintenance costs beyond the current five-year financial plan
- Replacing 'like-for-like' in the case of infrastructure replacements – and that any upsizing required for development would be paid for through development charges.







## Rate Increase Options & Impacts

The CVRD understands that any rate increase is difficult for ratepayers – and that increases to water rates might be only one of a few cost increases they'll see in the years to come. Directors considered the cost impacts for residents, and balancing the interests for current and future users, and will review every four years.
