Comox Valley Emergency Management is encouraging residents to register for local emergency notifications.

The "Get Notified" system is a free, subscription-based service that allows local governments to distribute local emergency alerts by text message and voice calls about incidents that could impact you. Registration is required to receive these local emergency alerts.

The registration process is simple for setting up your account, visit: **comoxvalleyrd.ca/getnotified** and follow the steps outlined. Make sure to register for emergency notifications for the communities in which you live, work and play.
