- Postmarks will not be accepted as the date of receipt by the CVRD.
- Elector response forms being submitted electronically via email must be submitted as either a scanned copy or a photo of an original signed form.
- Accurate copies of this Elector Response Form may be made and used for signing.
- A person may not sign more than one Elector Response Form.
- The Board may proceed with the adoption of Bylaw No. 844 being "Union Bay Fire Protection Service Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 844, 2024" unless 104 electors sign and submit a completed elector response form by the deadline.

Bylaw No. 844 Synopsis

The purpose of Bylaw No. 844 is to authorize the borrowing of an amount not to exceed two million, seven hundred, fifty-five thousand dollars (\$2,755,000) for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new fire hall for the Union Bay Fire Protection Service. The debt servicing cost will be recovered over a period not exceeding 25 years through the annual requisition for the service. It is estimated that the borrowing will result in a tax increase for the average residential property of \$202.92 per year until the debt is retired. The service area is comprised of properties within the whole of the boundaries of the Union Bay Fire Protection Service Area.

Elector Eligibility Requirements

Resident elector (section 65 of the *Local Government Act*)

- be 18 years of age or older;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months;
- be a resident of the jurisdiction (e.g., municipality or electoral area);
- live in the area defined for the AAP; and,
- not be disqualified under the Local Government Act, or any other enactment from voting in a local election or be otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-resident property electors (section 66 of the Local Government Act)

- 18 years of age or older;
- a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before signing this form;
- not entitled to vote as a resident elector in the area defined for the AAP;
- a registered owner of real property in the area defined for the AAP for at least 30 days before signing this form;
- not be disqualified from voting under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment or otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Additional notes for non-resident property elector(s): Only one non-resident property elector may sign an elector response form per property, regardless of how many people own the property; and, that owner must have the written consent of a majority of the other property owner(s) to sign the response form on their behalf. Property owned in whole or in part by a corporation does not qualify under the non-resident property elector provisions.
