What The CVRD Budget Means To You

The Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) Board adopted its 2025 - 2029 financial plan comprised of \$111.6 million for the 2025 operating budget and \$102.8 million for the 2025 capital budget. The tax impact on the average home in each specific area varies and is dependent on the unique mix of services provided to each area.
